The <u>Iowa Credit Union Foundation</u> (ICUF) has activated its Disaster Relief Grant Program in order to support credit union members impacted by the March 5 tornadoes and storms across Iowa. We have also organized a <u>list of resources</u> available to Iowans impacted.

Disaster grants provide emergency cash assistance to lowa credit union members who have experienced significant damage to their homes and are displaced due to a natural



disaster. With the goal of assisting as many credit union members as possible, all disaster grant applications are prioritized based on severity of damage and member financial need. Legal Tip: Responding to Member Complaints

Both the <u>National Credit Union Administration</u> (NCUA) and the <u>Iowa Division of Credit Unions</u> report an increase in complaints from credit union members. If your credit union receives notice that a complaint has been filed, remember to:



- Respond within 20 days.
- Respond with facts only, and to provide documents in support of those facts.
- Do not include personally identifiable information for the member in your response.
- Include a description of how your credit union has acted in accordance with the member account agreement.
